



Customising your lighting pattern

- Press the $\circ\circ$ **3** key twice in succession to access the lighting setting mode.
- Now select the desired colour of the lighting with the FN + ScrLk keys.
- Now press the key you want to light up.
- Press the $\circ\circ$ key to save the light setting.

Locking the Windows kev

- Press the **G** key to lock the Windows key.
- Press the **G** key again to unlock the Win key.

Setting the volume

- Turn the volume control 4 to set the desired volume.
- Press the volume control 4 to mute the sound.
- Press the volume control 4 again to unmute the sound.

Special functions Lighting

- Press the **FN+**▲ keys to increase the brightness of the lighting.
- Press the **FN+**▼ keys to decrease the brightness of the lighting.
- Press the **FN+** ◀ or **FN+** keys to change the direction of the lighting effects.
- Press the **FN+**= + keys to increase the speed of the lighting effects.
- Press the **FN+**⁻ keys to decrease the speed of the lighting effects.
- Press the FN+ScrLk keys to change the colour selection for the lighting.

Lighting pattern

Use the FN+INS, FN+HOME, FN+PgUp, FN+DEL, FN+End or FN+PgDn keys to select the desired lighting pattern.

Three different lighting profiles are stored on each of the key combinations named above.


