


## Making a WLAN connection

A connection to the Internet is necessary in order to use this product to its full extent. This can be through a network cable or through WLAN. Proceed as follows to set up a WLAN connection:

1. Make sure that the WLAN function is switched on. Check the  indicator light for this. Refer to the detailed instruction manual for the correct key combination.
2. Click on the icon at upper left corner of the screen.
3. Click on the WLAN network to which you want to connect.
4. If a new window appears requesting authentication, enter the required WLAN key or password and click **Connect**.

## Installing a new version of MEDION® FastBoot

1. Download the current version from the Medion website.
2. Start the **VR-pulse Installer** in the Windows **Control Panel**.
3. Uninstall the current version of the program by clicking the **Uninstall** button.
4. Click **Install** to install the new version.
5. All data, settings and downloaded updates will be deleted and will need to be re-installed. After installing a new version, optimizations will be performed during the first re-start, which will make the startup time longer. Subsequent restarts will not be affected.

## Restore to factory default

You can restore MEDION® FastBoot to the default settings by clicking **Restore to factory default** in the MEDION® FastBoot Control Panel.

### Warning!

All your current settings will be reset to the factory defaults and you have to download the upgrades like Google Chrome & VLC-player once again.

You will find a machine-readable source code of the components described on the disk supplied. Please pay attention to the copyright notice, the guarantee terms and the licensing conditions that are attached to the source code.

## MEDION® FastBoot



The MEDION® FastBoot system enables fast and easy access to the Internet browser, email and social networks without having to carry out a complete system start.

### Warning!

You must complete the initial **Set Up Windows** procedure for the Windows® operating system before starting MEDION® FastBoot for the first time. See the corresponding section under **Getting Started** in the **Instruction manual**.

## Starting MEDION® FastBoot

### Information

Read this section through completely before you switch on the Notebook. The option to start MEDION® FastBoot appears quickly, and only briefly, so you are likely to miss it otherwise.

Start the application as follows:

1. Switch on the notebook with the On /Off switch.
2. Rapidly tap the **F9** key 2-3 times when you see the message **Press F9 for Medion FastBoot OS**.
3. MEDION® FastBoot will now start.

### Warning!

Settings to optimize the function of MEDION® FastBoot will run in the background when it has been started for the first time. This process will last several minutes and will only take place after the first start. **Do not switch off** the Notebook during this process.

## Configuring MEDION® FastBoot

To configure MEDION® FastBoot:


1. Open the **Control Panel** by clicking on the icon with the screwdriver and pliers.
2. Select **Preferred OS** ⇒ **FastBoot** in order to establish FastBoot as the standard operating system, or select **Preferred OS** ⇒ **Microsoft Windows**, in order to establish **Microsoft Windows** as the **preferred operating system**.
3. Your notebook will start automatically with the preferred operating system at the next start.

### Note

If FastBoot is selected as the preferred OS it will no longer be necessary to start **MEDION® FastBoot** with the aid of the **F9 button**. You can naturally also make the same settings with the **Microsoft Windows**, as described above, under the **MEDION® FastBoot** option.

## User interface

The various icons along the bottom of the screen allow you to check your email, surf the internet, chat on social networks, and more.

## Information about operation

- You can modify various power saving settings in Control Panel, **Power Management**. Switch the Notebook off to avoid unnecessary power consumption if not using **MEDION FastBoot** for an extended time.
- Bluetooth and USB 3.0 are not supported by MEDION® FastBoot™.
- Compatibility with all USB media is not guaranteed; external optical drives are not supported, for example.
- The playing back of copy-protected content is not supported.


## Switching off MEDION® FastBoot

You can switch off MEDION® FastBoot either by means of the  button or by means of the on /off switch of the Notebook.

## Switching the Language

Medion® FastBoot is set to English language by default.

1. A selection window will open at the first start and you will be able to select your language.
2. You can change the settings at any time by means of the **Control Panel**, by clicking on the icon with the screwdriver and pliers.



3. Close the **Control Panel** Window by clicking cross at the upper right corner.

### Attention!

The default language (English US) matches the physical keyboard layout. Keyboard settings for other languages match physical keyboards from those countries and may differ from the Notebooks physical layout.

Special symbols such as @, +, -, etc. may require using different keys.
