Instructions for Full Software Update



The complete firmware update will erase all settings.

To update the device's firmware, proceed as follows:

- Format a USB stick to the FAT32 file system.
- Copy the extracted file to the USB stick without any subfolders.
- Unplug the power cord from the outlet.
- Connect the USB stick to the device.
- Plug the power cord back into the outlet.
- The update will now be installed during the boot process (if a blue screen with a progress indicator does not appear, repeat steps 1-5 and try again).
- The device will automatically restart after the update is completed; the USB stick must be removed.
- The initial start-up after the update will take some time. Do not interrupt the start-up until the initial setup is complete.



IMPORTANT!

Do not interrupt the power supply or remove the USB stick during the update process.

- After the update installation, the initial setup menu will appear automatically (the LED will light up normally).
 - Turn the device off and on again. The update is now complete.
